Westchester Land Trust is soliciting pricing for Asbestos Abatement at 100 Little Pond Road, Patterson, NY 12563. Representatives of Quality Environmental Solutions & Technologies, Inc. will be performing the project monitoring and third-party air sampling on the project.

Scope of Abatement Project: The Abatement Contractor will be responsible for the abatement and disposal of friable asbestos-containing joint compound and non-friable asbestos-containing floor tile & mastic, vinyl floor tiles, window glazing, chimney flashing tar on the main house located at 100 Little Pond Road, Patterson, NY 12563. The Abatement Contractor will also be responsible for the abatement and disposal of non-friable asbestos-containing anti-sweat tar on the sink and non-friable asbestos-containing cementitious siding on building 94, non-friable asbestos-containing window glazing on building 100B, non-friable asbestos-containing cementitious panels and window glazing on building 100C, non-friable asbestos-containing transite/cementitious panels and window glazing on building 100E.

The Abatement Contractor shall maintain sole responsibility for means and methods utilized for execution of the work scope. The Abatement Contractor shall perform all work on this project in compliance with Title 12 NYCRR Part 56-11.5 and all other Federal, State, Municipal and Local Legal requirements. The Abatement Contractor acknowledges that the Owner's Representative shall have Stop Work Authority over all work activities occurring at the site. The Abatement Contractor's Lump Sum Price shall include all costs for Labor, Material and Equipment necessary to remove and dispose of all of the ACM and all other environmental conditions/materials identified within this specification.

Pricing: Pricing to include, but not be limited to, all labor, materials, travel, disposal and notification fees. Westchester Land Trust reserves the right to reject or accept any or all proposals. Westchester Land Trust reserves the right to seek clarification of information submitted in response to this RFP and/or request additional information during the evaluation process. Westchester Land Trust also reserves the right to select any proposal as the basis for negotiating a contract, to exercise its discretion and apply its judgement with respect to any aspect of this RFP, the evaluation of proposals and the negotiation and award of any contract; and to weigh its evaluation criteria in any manner it deems appropriate.

<u>**Pre-Work Submittals:**</u> Provide current copies of NYSDOL Company Asbestos License, NYSDOL Asbestos Supervisor Certificate, NYSDOL Asbestos Handler Certificates, respirator fits, medical approvals, name of OSHA competent person to perform personal air monitoring and supervise the abatement project and proposed laboratory for analysis of personal air samples to the Owner's representative.

A detailed project schedule and insurance certificate (see attached for requirements) shall be submitted with your proposal. No work will be permitted prior to receipt of all required submittals. Westchester Land Trust shall be listed as both the Certificate Holder and Additional Insured. Quality Environmental Solutions & Technologies, Inc. shall be listed as an Additional Insured.

Project Phasing: There is no project phasing.

Timing of Abatement: The Abatement Contractor shall coordinate the abatement project with Westchester Land Trust and its representatives. This Abatement Contractor shall schedule the abatement to ensure that the Owner's schedule is maintained. The Abatement Contractor shall include sufficient time within the designated work shift to 1) remove ACM, 2) remove and properly package all ACM waste for disposal, and 3) thoroughly clean and/or HEPA vacuum the entire work area. In addition to providing access to GFCI electrical power within the regulated work area, the Abatement Contractor shall provide access to GFCI electrical power and cords, required to perform the air monitoring for this project, immediately adjacent to and within the regulated area.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): The Abatement Contractor shall provide, require and ensure the use of protective clothing, such as coveralls or similar whole-body clothing, head coverings, gloves and foot coverings for any employee entering the regulated area. The Abatement Contractor shall provide, require and ensure the use of respiratory protection for all employees entering the regulated area. The Abatement Contractor shall be responsible for complying with applicable provisions of 29 CFR 1926, 29 CFR 1910 and all legal requirements during execution of the entire work scope.

<u>**Temporary Facilities:**</u> The Abatement Contractor shall take over the area as is. The Abatement Contractor is responsible for securing and providing all power and water for the project and establishing all temporary GFCI hookups necessary to complete the work. The locations of all temporary electrical/water sources shall be coordinated with the Owner's representative. The location for placement of all temporary facilities, equipment and containers shall be permitted, if applicable and shall be approved by the Owner's Representative.

Project Notifications: The Abatement Contractor shall be responsible for providing all labor, material and equipment for timely preparation and submittal of all required Regulatory Notifications and associated fees. The Abatement Contractor shall be responsible for obtaining all necessary permits, prepare and submit all required applications and pay all associated fees for conduct of this asbestos abatement project. Copies of all pending or approved applications and notifications with documentation of payment shall be provided to the Owner's representative. The Abatement Contractor's authorized representative shall provide copies of the following:

- Regulatory Notifications –NYSDOL & EPA Notifications and Building Occupant Notification (Building to be posted by the Abatement Contractor).
- Alternative Work Practices The Abatement Contractor shall prepare and submit any request to the owner's consultant, for any site-specific variance from Title 12 NYCRR Part 56 (Subparts 56-1 through 56-12) with ample time prior to the commencement of work. Work involving a variance may not commence prior to the receipt of the Department of Labor's approval of the application. The "Asbestos Variance Application" for (NYSDOL DOSH 752) and all supporting documentation shall be prepared by the owner's consultant/project designer and submitted to NYSDOL for approval.

Final Cleaning & Clearance Air Sampling: The Contractor and the Owner's representative shall perform a detailed visual inspection at the end of each work shift to ensure that all debris has been properly removed from the work area. The Owner's third-party air monitor shall perform Aggressive Clearance Air Sampling at the completion of each work area. Upon notification, of satisfactory clearance air monitoring, from the Owner's third-party monitoring firm, the Contractor shall breakdown the work area and remove all of their equipment. In the event clearance air monitoring results are not acceptable, the Contractor shall immediately re-clean the work area; using HEPA vacuum equipment. The cost of re- cleaning and testing shall be the responsibility of this Contractor.

Removal of Waste from the Site: All waste generated as part of the asbestos project shall be removed from the site within 48 hours after successful completion of Final Cleaning & Clearance Air Sampling at the site. All waste generated during the asbestos project shall be legally disposed of at an approved landfill facility by the owners consultant prior to the start of any work. All generated waste removed from the site must be documented, accounted for and disposed of in compliance with the requirements of EPA NESHAP.

<u>Westchester Land Trust Site Responsibilities</u>: Westchester Land Trust will be responsible for the following:

• To notify the power company to disconnect the power to the property which is currently nonoperational, Disconnection of electrical system back to the poles.
