WLT also collaborates with local conservation groups to increase the pace of conservation in Westchester County by providing assistance with mapping, technical and strategic support for protecting parcels, as well as assistance with communications, marketing and development.

Through WLT's Veg+Chester program, farmers who need land are connected to property owners who have land to lease. As a result, this program ensures that land with agricultural value stays in production, there is an increase in the quantity and quality of locally grown food in the County, and young farmers who don't have the resources to purchase land in Westchester have the opportunity to farm here. In total, there are 25 acres of land in production engaging two dozen farmers and landowners/farm operations. WLT's Sugar Hill Farm is also a part of this program working with the Food Bank for Westchester to grow vegetables for distribution to local food pantries. The 2014 growing season at Sugar Hill Farm produced more than 4,800 servings of high-nutrition value produce for the Food Bank.

WLT conducted several major land management and stewardship efforts in 2014 on lands that it own in fee. Every trail at WLT preserves was inspected by staff or volunteers and cleared of obstructions, overgrowth, and enhanced, where necessary to improve access. Habitat

Enhancement Initiatives (HEIs) were conducted at the Westchester

Wilderness Walk/Zofnass Family Preserve, Hunterbrook Preserve and the

Frederick P. Rose Preserve. The HEIs are intended to be an ongoing

effort by WLT to identify important stewardship goals at specific

preserves, and to execute them over multiple years. These stewardship

goals can include such efforts as invasive species management, native

plant restoration, stream bank remediation and meadow restoration.
