In addition to land preservation, WLT is committed to community
education about the protection of natural resources, wildlife habitats
and sustainable agriculture. WLT accomplished this through a regular
preserve hike series, habitat restoration projects at WLT preserves,

with organizations such as Atmosphere Academy, Pace University,

These projects are guided by the management plans that WLT prepares for each of its owned properties, that identify and prioritize stewardship needs for each. These stewardship goals include invasive species removal, native plant restoration, stream bank remediation, forest restoration and meadow restoration. These projects typically involve extensive acreage, and take multiple years to execute.

WLT, in partnership with Highstead in Connecticut, co-founded and is a current member of a consortium of over 50 conservation partners known as the Hudson to Housatonic Regional Conservation Partnership (H2HRCP).

The goal of this two-state (NY and CT) initiative is to accelerate the pace of land conservation and stewardship in the region through effective partnering across municipal boundaries. This partnership has raised the visibility of conservation efforts in the region and helped to garner funding and other support for specific land conservation projects.
