Westchester Land Trust created the Pollinator Pop-Up to provide user-friendly information about bees, butterflies, hummingbirds, and other pollinators.

These tiny workers pollinate nearly one-third of the food we eat and many of the plants we enjoy—but habitat loss and other threats have caused drastic declines in their populations.

The good news is that everyone can help pollinators, whether you have 10 acres or live in a 10th-floor apartment!
